#### Primary Intake – September 2024

If you have a child that is due to start school next September (born between 1st September 2019 and 31st August 2020) the on-line application admission opens on 15 November 2023 and closes on 15 January 2024, the national closing date. Lincolnshire has a final closing date of 9 February 2024 for late applications and changes.

#### Wellies
