Message from the Principal

This term is relatively short in comparison to the Autumn term, but that means there is a lot to pack into a short space of time! I would ask for your continued support to ensure your children are in school on time and as regularly as possible so they maximise the learning opportunities we provide for them. This also extends to supporting and encouraging them to engage with any home learning they are set including practicing their number facts and times tables on 'Times Table Rockstars' as well as daily reading practice.

Language and reading are so important to the educational outcomes of children and regular daily practice is key. I want to share with you a piece of educational research as evidence of the importance of children reading outside of school:

- A pupil who reads 21 minutes per day outside of school reads almost 2 million words per year.
- A pupil who reads for less than a minute per day outside of school reads only 8,000 to 21,000 words per year.

From that evidence it is clear the advantage to vocabulary and comprehension by reading regularly at home. I would encourage you to ensure your child is maximising their reading and exposure to new vocabulary as it is so important to their successful cognitive development.

'Theddlethorpe Reading Raffle'

Every time your child has read at home, please mark in their reading record. When they reach any certificate (bronze, silver and so on), they will receive a raffle ticket to pop their name on and put into a box. At the end of each half term a raffle ticket will be picked out to receive a small prize. More reads = more tickets, more tickets = more chances to win! In classes we are currently reading:
